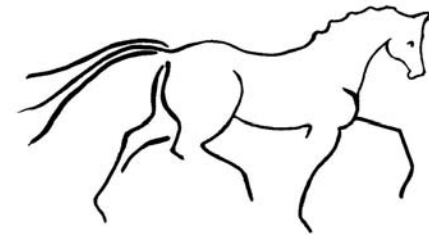

GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION

ENTRY FEES	\$16 per class. (\$15 pre-entry prior to Saturday @ 6 PM, fax or email acceptable). Entries or changes must be made at least 15 minutes prior to start of class entered. Jumper classes \$21 (or \$20 pre-entry). (\$5 add-back; 1st -50%, 2 nd - 30%, 3 rd -20%). Payment or open check required for issuance of number. Horses brought for schooling only must register and pay grounds fee of \$20.
COGGINS	NEGATIVE COGGINS test must be presented to the show secretary for all horses. Test must be less than 12 months old per Texas law.
STALL FEE	\$15 per day, including shavings or \$25 overnight.
CONCESSIONS	Served on the premises.
HARD HATS & BOOTS	ASTM approved helmets must be worn when mounted. Half chaps permitted if same color as boots.
EQUIPMENT	Martingales are not allowed in flat classes. Polo wraps and boots are not allowed in hunter classes unless approved by Show Manager (i.e. inclement weather).
DOGS	All dogs must be on a leash.
SCHOOLING	Allowed Saturday after 2:00 p.m. Sun. until 15 min. before start of show. Ring 1 open for brief schooling after jumpers. Ring 2 open briefly between 12 & 1 PM.

The Show Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine any classes or do anything deemed necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. The management shall decide all questions not covered in the USEF rules and regulations.

Condition of Entry and right to enter onto show grounds: SBEC, Inc., its employees, Bill & Cathy Strobel, volunteers, officials and anyone associated with the preceding will in no case be held responsible for any articles lost, stolen or damaged nor liable for any injury sustained by any horse, exhibitor, spectator, volunteer or employee whether due to negligence or inherent risk.

WARNING: Under Texas Law (Chap. 87, civil Practice and Remedies Code) an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

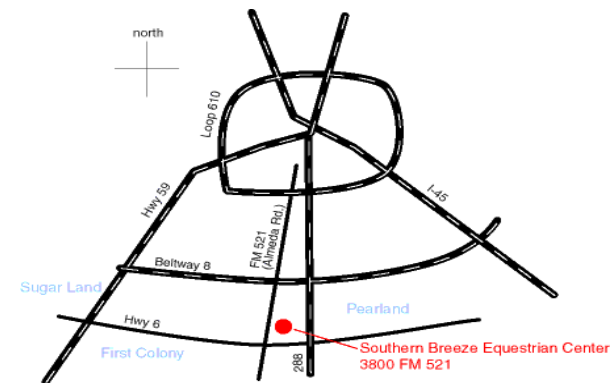

RECOGNIZED DIVISIONS

EQUITATION DIVISIONS

ALL EQUITATION CLASSES TO BE JUDGED ON HANDS, LEGS, SEAT, CONTROL OF MOUNT AND TURNOUT.

Walk-Trot Equitation: No cross entries into any other divisions. Walk/Trot Equitation over ground poles, Walk/Trot Figure Eight Test, Walk/Trot Horsemanship, and Walk/Trot Equitation.

Pre-Beginner Equitation: No cross entries into any other divisions. Fences 18" (small X's) with a jump course of twice around. Participants may trot or canter fences with leads between jumps not to count. Walk/Trot Equitation, Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation and two Equitation Over Fences classes.

Beginner Equitation: No cross entries. For riders who have not shown over fences exceeding 2'3". Fences 2' (X's or verticals) with a course of twice around. The last course may have one diagonal line. Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation and three Equitation Over Fences classes.

Adult Beginner Equitation: No cross entries into over fences classes in any other divisions. Open to adult amateur riders who have not shown over fences exceeding 2' in any show. Fences 2' max. Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation and three Equitation Over Fences classes.

Novice Equitation: For riders who have not shown over fences exceeding 2'6". Fences 2'3". No in-and-outs. Novice Equitation flat and three Equitation Over Fences classes.

Open Equitation: Open to all. One flat and three over fences classes. One class to include 2 USEF tests 1-18, no switching of horses. Fences 2'9" – 3'.

COMBINATION DIVISIONS

(Hunter and Equitation) Points are awarded to the horse and rider combination.

Junior/Adult Division: Open to junior riders and adult amateurs. Fences 2'9" – 3'. One Equitation Flat, one Equitation Over Fences which must include 2 of USEF tests 1-9, one Hunter Under Saddle and two Hunter Over Fences.

Limit Division: Open to junior and adult amateur riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons over courses of 2'6" or higher. Fences 2'6" – 2'9". One Equitation Flat, one Equitation Over Fences which must include 2 of USEF tests 1-9, one Hunter Under Saddle and two Hunter Over Fences.

Adult Low Division: Open to all adult amateurs who have reached their 25th birthday as of December 1 of the competition year. Fences 2'-3", courses to be simple. 5 classes; one equitation flat, one Equitation Over Fences, one Hunter Under Saddle and two Hunter Over Fences.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Pony Hunter: Open to ponies 14.2 hands and under ridden by junior riders. Fences 2' - 2'3". No in-and-outs.

Low Hunter: Open to all. Fences 2' - 2'3", no in-and-outs.

Schooling Hunter: Open to all. Fences 2'6".

Open Hunter: Open to all. Fences 2'9"-3'.

JUMPER DIVISIONS

CONSISTS OF THREE CLASSES: 1. Time First Jump Off, Table II, Sec. 2 (a/b) 2. Time First Round, Table II, Sec. 1, 3. Fault and Out, Table II, Sec. 4.

Itty Bitty Jumper: Fences 2'3" to 2'6". Spreads not wider than fence height plus 3". Horse may not cross enter into any other jumper division at the same show.

Schooling Jumper: Open to all. Fences 2'9"-3'. Spreads not wider than fence height plus 3".

Open Jumper: Open to all. Fences 3'3"- to 3'6". Spreads not wider than fence height plus 3".

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

WALK ONLY EQUITATION AND WALK/TROT WITH ASSISTANCE – Classes will be held approx. between 12:00 and 1:00 PM. All entries will be led and may have side walkers. No cross entries except into pole bending.

WARM-UP CLASSES – A warm-up class will be held for each arena. Judge's cards may be held open through several divisions.

PAIRS HACK – Open to all, English or Western. Pairs of horses and riders to work abreast in unison. To be judged on manners, ability to work as a team, way of going and turnout.

POLE BENDING – English or Western. Open to all. A fun timed event. A separate class with leaders for riders will be formed if entries permit.

RIDE A \$5! – A fun bareback ride! Open to all. Regular entry fee applies, SBEC provides the \$5. Winner takes home the bucks! Juniors and amateurs only.

CHAMPION/ RESERVE CHAMPION AWARDS

Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons and awards will be given in each division. Winners can choose their awards from an assortment of amazing prizes!
